Job Summary: A Welder helps maintain the functionality of the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Plant.

Essential Functions:

- Utilizes a Task Card for all work performed.
- Follow the policies and procedures of Willmar Electric – including safety standards.
- Train and mentor craft workers in your area.
- Layout, plan and install work for self.
- Gather tools and supplies to be used at the work site (including hand and power tools).
- Maintain company tools, equipment, supplies and materials in an orderly fashion.
- Complete hot work permits before performing the task – dependent on specific zone worked in.
- Use electricity and torches to produce heat and solder together components made from steel, titanium, copper and other metals.
- Assess equipment, structures, materials and job specifications for appropriate welding positions and methods.
- Maintains a thorough knowledge of universal standards and specifications in order to meet building codes and legal requirements.

- Cut, trim and fabricate metal components using heat, fire and electricity.
- Monitors work environment for hazards and maintains healthy ventilation levels to avoid particle or gas inhalation.
- Assists the mechanical technicians and electricians in setting up cable pulls, moving switch gear and heavy panels.
- Coordinate and complete maintenance for airlines.
- Ability to utilize power industrial vehicles and maintain certifications.
- Adapt to changing priorities, including performing other duties for your supervisor.

- Hold and maintain appropriate licensing for Mechanical/Maintenance JM or apprentice license, as required.
- Have OSHA10 hour prior to beginning work on a site or the pre-fabrication workshop.
